If you were warned about danger, would you walk into it?

Was Paul being disobedient seeing as it was the Spirit that was warning him?

Why would Paul walk into danger and certain suffering?

Can you think of times when you decided to choose risky option and potential suffering over the easy way? Why did you do it?

Paul was misunderstood and seen as a traitor to his Jewish heritage. How might that affect him? How might that tempt him to abandon gospel principles?

Have you ever been caught between doing what's right, and doing what others think is right? What did you decide to do and how did you decide?

Have you ever been misunderstood and/or had your motives questioned and misinterpreted? How did you feel about that?

Why is it that Christians should expect to have their characters attacked and undermined?

What should we do if our character is being attacked unjustly?
